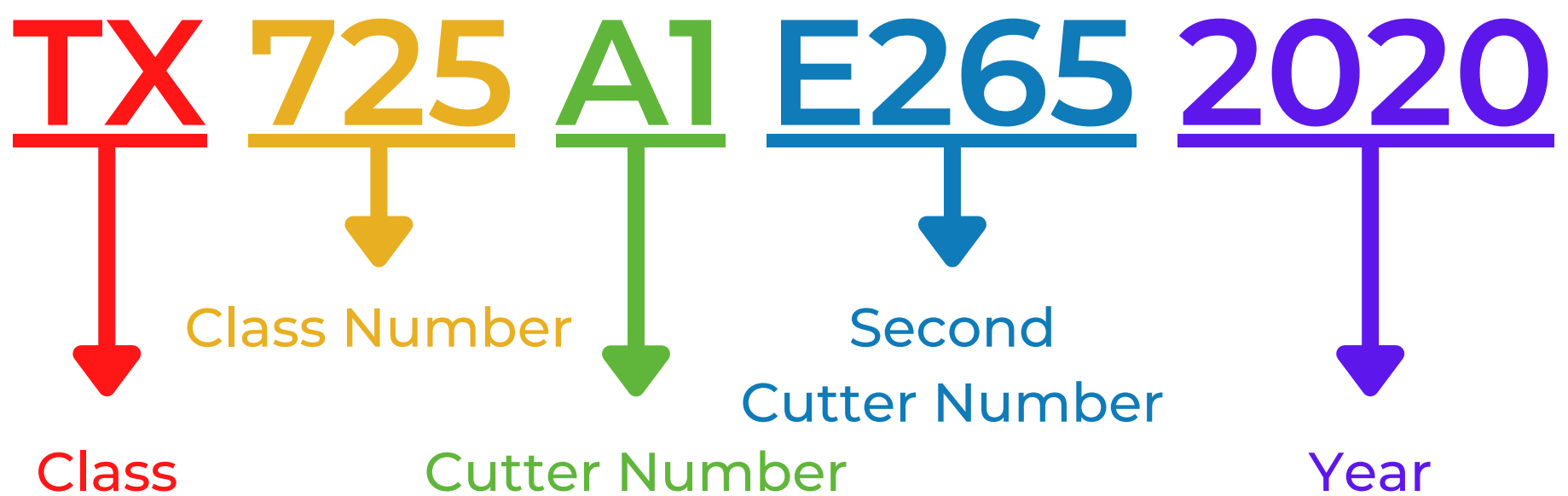

# How to Find a Book Using a Call Number

Break down the call number into the sections described below to find your book.



**Class:** Books are arranged most broadly by their Class, which is assigned based on subject. Sections are ordered alphabetically.  
*e.g. M comes before T*

**Class Number:** Starts at 1 and goes up from there. They function as whole numbers and are organized numerically.  
*e.g. 75 comes before 725*

**Cutter Number:** Made up of a letter and a number. Browse first alphabetically by letter and then numerically by number.

**Second Cutter Number:** May follow the first cutter number. Search in the same way. *Second cutter numbers may not always be present.*

**Year:** Represents the year a book was published. It functions as a whole number and is searched numerically.

If you can't find your book, or it's not where it should be, ask a library team member for help.
